

CAMP H2O RULES & REGULATIONS



1. No one is to leave the camp or to have visitors unless special permission is obtained first from the Camp Director.
2. Men and women will be housed in separate buildings. At NO TIME will students be permitted in a cabin of the opposite sex.
3. Drugs and alcohol, including tobacco, will not be allowed for the duration of the camp. All prescription and over-the-counter drugs must be turned over to and distributed by the Camp Nurse. All prescription and over-the-counter drugs must be in their original containers.

Any infraction of the above rules will lead to immediate dismissal from the program!

4. Be on time for all meals, workshops, general sessions, and small groups. Students and staff are expected to participate in all scheduled activities.
5. Electronic devices (phones, Nintendo DS's, etc.) are allowed, but can only be used during designated free time and up until lights out. If being used during workshops, general sessions, activities, etc. they will be confiscated and given back the next morning.
6. There will be no switching of room assignments, group assignments, etc. without the approval of the Camp Director.

7. The camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
Please leave all personal items that you do not want lost or stolen at home.
8. Campers (and staff) will be expected to adhere to all safety regulations.
9. Please be respectful of the facilities and the outdoors, pick up after yourself and put litter where it belongs.
10. Absolutely no PUT DOWNS!
11. All camp participants are to make at least one new friend.
